You can use [CSS Overrides](#) to change the link colors. Right click the link then click Inspect Element. Select the line in the HTML that contains the link. Find the link's class name in styles.

Copy the class name and add code to CSS overrides, like the following.

```
.axero-wall-container .axero-wall-entry .axero-wall-entry-right a {  
  color: #2975B0;  
}
```

Add the following code in CSS overrides and update font-size:

```
.axero-article-list-description { font-size: 1.1em; }
```

Use the following code in CSS overrides and update color and font-size.

```
.articlelist .span9 h4 { color: #ccc; font-size: 2em; }
```
